## **BMS NJHS Member Selection Procedure**

The National Junior Honor Society chapter of Barboursville Middle School is a duly chartered and affiliated chapter of this prestigious national organization. Membership is open to those students who meet the required standards in five areas of evaluation: **Scholarship, Service, Leadership, Character, and Citizenship.** Students are selected for membership by majority vote of a five-member principal-appointed faculty council, which bestows this honor upon qualified students on behalf of the faculty of our school each academic year.

Students in grades **7** and **8** are eligible for membership **if** the following criteria are met.

Candidates must receive a cumulative score of **90%** or higher on the items listed below to be considered for membership.

- 1. A cumulative GPA of **3.75 or higher** will include the final 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade GPA and the first nine weeks GPA. New students to BMS must be enrolled by September 1 each year to be considered for membership, using the same criteria. **10 points**
- 2. Students must obtain a positive behavior report while enrolled at Barboursville Middle School. **10 points**
- 3. Students must complete a candidate information packet. The packet must be completed fully, written neatly in black ink, and returned by the due date. Late packets will not be accepted. 1**0 points**
- Students will complete a proctored essay during the school day. The essay will be graded by a rubric by two Faculty Council Members. Students will receive two scores for this criterion, 10 points each.

Candidates will receive written notification pertaining to membership. All candidates accepted for membership must be inducted into the Barboursville Middle School NJHS (National Junior Honor Society). Members **MUST** embody the high standards of the Barboursville NJHS to obtain membership. Those falling below the standard will be placed on probation and/or dismissed from membership.
