

CABELL COUNTY SCHOOLS HEALTH SERVICES GUIDELINES

Lice

- Students with live lice will be sent home and able to return when there are not any live lice present
- It is recommended that nits are combed out of hair as they may hatch into live lice
- Lice education sheets are available at each school

Vomiting

- Student will be sent home if he/she has one episode of vomiting (unless known cause with medical documentation)
- Student may return to school 24 hours after last episode of vomiting
- Student should be able to tolerate food/drink before returning to school

Diarrhea

- Student will be sent home if he/she has 2 more stools than typical during a school day
- Student may return to school when symptoms have improved (at least 24 hours after leaving school)
- Student should be able to tolerate food/drink before returning to school

Fever

- Student will be sent home if he/she has a body temperature of 100.4° F or higher.
- Student will remain at home until the temperature remains below 100.4° F for 24 hours with no fever reducing medications.
